Recipe of the Month

Venison Queso Dip



Ingredients:

- 1 cup ground venison
- 2 teaspoons creole seasoning
- 1 teaspoon chili powder
- 1 teaspoon cumin
- Salt and pepper, to taste
- 16 ounces Velveeta, cubed
- 1 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese
- 1 cup canned diced tomatoes
- 1/2 cup canned chopped green chiles
- 1/2 cup Salsa Verde

Directions:

- Brown the ground venison. While it's browning add in the creole seasoning, chili powder, cumin, salt, and pepper.
- Cook until browned. Set aside.
- Add cubed Velveeta and shredded Monterey jack cheese to a small crock pot on high.
- Once cheese is melted, add the tomato, green chiles, salsa, and meat to crock pot.
- Mix well, let it heat through, and serve hot.
