Recipe of the Month

Mojo Walleye

Ingredients

2 large walleye fillets

Marinade

- 4 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/2 tablespoon fresh coarse ground black pepper
- 1 tablespoon fresh thyme
- 1/2 tablespoon fresh oregano
- 1/2 teaspoon cayenne pepper

Directions

In a plastic zipper bag, combine 2 large walleye fillets with the marinade ingredients; marinate for 3 hours.

To cook: Grill, broil or pan-fry. Total cooking time should be about 15 to 20 minutes.
