Rules of the Month

This month's rules are from the **General Range Rules**.

Rule #10: All pistols must be unloaded and cased, or holstered when going to and from the ranges.

Rule #11: No youths under the age of 12 may be in or on firearms ranges.

Rule #12: Persons between the ages of 12 and their 18th birthday must be supervised by an adult who is range certified.

Recipe of the Month**Slow Cooker Rabbit****Ingredients**

- 1 rabbit jointed cut into pieces
- 2 onion chopped
- 1 garlic clove crushed
- 2 tbs oil
- 2 tbs tomato paste
- 2 bay leaf
- 3/4 cup water
- 2/3 cup red wine
- 1 tsp mixed herbs
- 1 cup peas
- 1 carrot peeled sliced
- 3 potato medium broken into chunks
- 1 beef stock cube crumbled
- 1 pinch seasoning *to taste

Directions

1. Heat oil in fry pan and lightly brown meat.
2. Lightly fry onion and garlic and add to cooker.
3. Place remaining ingredients, except the peas, into slow cooker. Cook on low for 6-8 hours.
4. Add the peas ½ hour before serving.
