

A free Hunter Education course will be offered at the club on April 11<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm and April 13<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 AM until 2:00 PM. As many of you are aware, these classes fill up very quickly. As a service to Conservation Club members this course will be available for early registration to club members and their immediate families. The course will open for public registration beginning April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Safe firearm handling, tree stand safety, hunting planning and safety are taught along with other New York State mandated content. Students successfully completing the course will be issued the Hunter Education Certificates of Qualification required to obtain small or large game hunting licenses. If you are planning to hunt during the spring turkey season, this is the class you need.

If you have an interest in attending this course, please contact Mike Cyr to reserve a spot as soon as possible. Mike will register you or your family member into the course to reserve your seat. To register you must be at least 11 years of age and provide all of the following student information:

- First, Middle and Last name as it will appear on a license
- Suffix if used (Jr, Sr, I, II, III etc.)
- Email address
- Date of Birth
- Sex
- Mailing zip code and address including town and county
- Phone
- Ethnicity or prefer not to disclose
- Special assistance needs (hearing, reading etc.)

Once Mike receives your complete information he will enter you into the DEC database and protect your seat. You will receive a confirming Email once the registration is completed.

Students may obtain the Student Manual at the club on Monday's during open trap (4:30 pm to 8:00 pm), from the Sweden Town Hall 18 State Street in Brockport or the Public Library on West Avenue. You may also download a copy from the DEC website. Download directions are available on the DEC website. The worksheets for the mandatory homework are included in the manual.
